

Declaration of Ferrari electronic AG for the fulfilment of the information obligation according to Article 33 of Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH)

The European Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH) requires companies to provide relevant information on substances that pose risks to humans and the environment. On 29 October 2008, the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) published for the first time a candidate list (Article 59 REACH, see <http://echa.europa.eu>) of substances of very high concern. The latest update to that list containing 250 substances of very high concern (SVHC) was published on June 25th, 2025.

Ferrari electronic is required by the legislator and by its customers to provide a proof that our products comply with the German and European law regulations.

Ferrari electronic AG hereby confirms that its products and their packaging do not contain any substances on the candidate list with a concentration of more than 0.1% by weight.
